SUBJECT: Election Deposits

Candidates who seek nominations in the forthcoming general elections are required to pay deposits in respect of the Constituencies for which they are contesting.

2. This deposit, which shall be made with the Returning Officer or with a Government Department authorised by the Returning Officer between the date of the issue of the Election Writ and twelve noon on the day of nomination, shall be \$500/- (in legal tender) in the case of an election to the Dewan Ra'ayat and \$250/- in the case of an election to the Council Negri. The amount deposited should be credited to Deposits-General, Code "DG".

3. The deposit may be paid individually by each candidate or collectively by the Political Party which nominates such candidates. In the latter case, it is very essential that a separate receipt, containing the following particulars, should be issued in respect of each candidate as the original receipt must be produced by the candidate before the Returning Officer at the time of nomination:-

- (a) The name of the depositor;
- (b) The address of depositor;
- (c) The name of the candidate;
- (d) The name and Code Number of the Constituency;
- (e) The amount of the deposit.

4. A deposit can only be withdrawn after the election and on receipt of authority from the Returning Officer. The deposit may be refunded to the depositor or forfeited in accordance with the Election Regulations. In the latter case, the Election Supervisor shall take the necessary action to adjust the forfeited deposit to the Government General Revenue.

5. In both cases, the withdrawal of a deposit should be debited to Deposits-General, Code "DG" and the original receipt issued to the depositor should be withdrawn to support the payment.

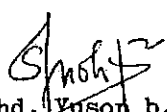

Adalah didapati bahawa kebanyakan Perbendaharaan Kecil sentiasa lambat menghantar akaun bulanan mereka ke Perbendaharaan Negeri untuk diperiksa yang mengakibatkan lambat untuk kami mengeluarkan penyata bulanan dan penyata tahunan.

2. Dengan itu kami ingin memohon jasa baik tuan Residen, untuk membantu kami dalam hal ini dengan mengarahkan semua perbendaharaan kecil di bawah kuasa tuan supaya dapat menghantar akaun bulanan dalam tempoh dua minggu selepas berakhir bulan tersebut; misalnya akaun bulan Mei seharusnya dihantar ke Perbendaharaan Negeri selewat-lewatnya pertengahan bulan Jun.

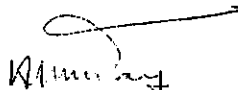

Menurut Arahan Perbendaharaan No. 145, Akaun Bulanan sepatutnya dihantar kepada Akauntan Negeri dalam tempoh sepuluh hari selepas setiap bulan. Walaubagaimanapun, dengan Arahan yang jelas itu, telah didapati ada stesen yang selalu lewat menghantar Akaun Bulanan mereka ke Pejabat kami. Amalan ini menimbulkan masalah kepada kami kerana Penyata Akaun Bulanan tidak dapat disediakan dalam masa yang ditetapkan. Oleh yang demikian, kerjasama adalah diperlukan daripada pihak tuan supaya menghantar Akaun Bulanan pada tepat masanya. Jikalau ada baucar yang belum dibayar atau ditandatangani atau seumpamanya, sesalinan fotostat baucar asal itu bersama dengan salinan keduanya (posting copy) hendaklah disertakan untuk tindakan kami, dan kemudian baucar asal itu hendaklah dihantar secepat mungkin selepas ianya dibayar atau ditandatangani. Jika Akaun Bulanan masih tidak dapat dihantar ke Pejabat kami pada akhir bulan selepas tempoh pengiriman ditutup, telegram mestilah dihantar dengan menjelaskan sebab-sebabnya.
